

Facebook will then send a code to your device, so you will need to enter this code each time you want to log in. This can be set up using your phone's SMS/MMS service, Google Authenticator, or similar software. Facebook's instructions for set-up are here. You can disable two-factor authentication by logging out of your Facebook account and logging back in. Social media use Facebook users will have regular status updates and feature use. Facebook users like many others of its generation can also connect with friends on other social media such as Twitter and Instagram. On July 13, 2014, Facebook released the Facebook Timeline. Prior to this update, Facebook user information was archived in an ephemeral manner, meaning Facebook users would be able to see what information had been posted on their profile, but would not be able to see the updated information. This was changed as of September 10, 2014, in order to allow Facebook users to see a time line of each part of their profile. In 2017, Facebook announced that they would begin to allow users to block other users from seeing their timeline, as well as update their messages. On September 18, 2019, Facebook released Facebook Messenger. The new messenger application has been built based on a new design which is supposed to offer a privacy-centered experience. Group membership In the past, users could create a group, and be part of that group. A group could be a private group, or a group that is open to anyone in the world. In the open group setting, a group member is listed as a member in the group's profile, and can send messages to other group members. A group member can also leave the group. In the private group setting, the group's members are displayed in the group's profile, but may be hidden by the administrator of the group. Groups are not deprecated, but they are not necessary for the functionality of Facebook; people can add friends or publish content on their own without creating a group. According to a survey by Pew Research Center, around 77 percent of Facebook users said they use Facebook groups. On October 17, 2009, Facebook released groups into the general public. An update to Facebook groups created a section in the public directory called groups that featured public groups with content such as events, local businesses and organizations, clubs, and groups within Facebook itself.
